MTEC offers more than six intensive courses that are enhanced versions of the National Propane Gas Association's Certified Employee Training Program (CETP). While traditionally taught as a textbook style course, MTEC has expanded the nationally recognized curriculum to include hands on training on various types of equipment.

Maine law requires that those who work with propane or natural gas be trained and licensed to do so. Under both CETP rules and Maine state requirements, all students must first pass and become certified in the course known as Basic Principles and Practices to qualify for any state license endorsements, or to receive certification in any other segment of CETP. Successful completion of each course, passage of the included test and submission of the related Skills Assessment Verification will earn NPGA certification. Achievement of NPGA certification will prep students for the state licensing exam.
